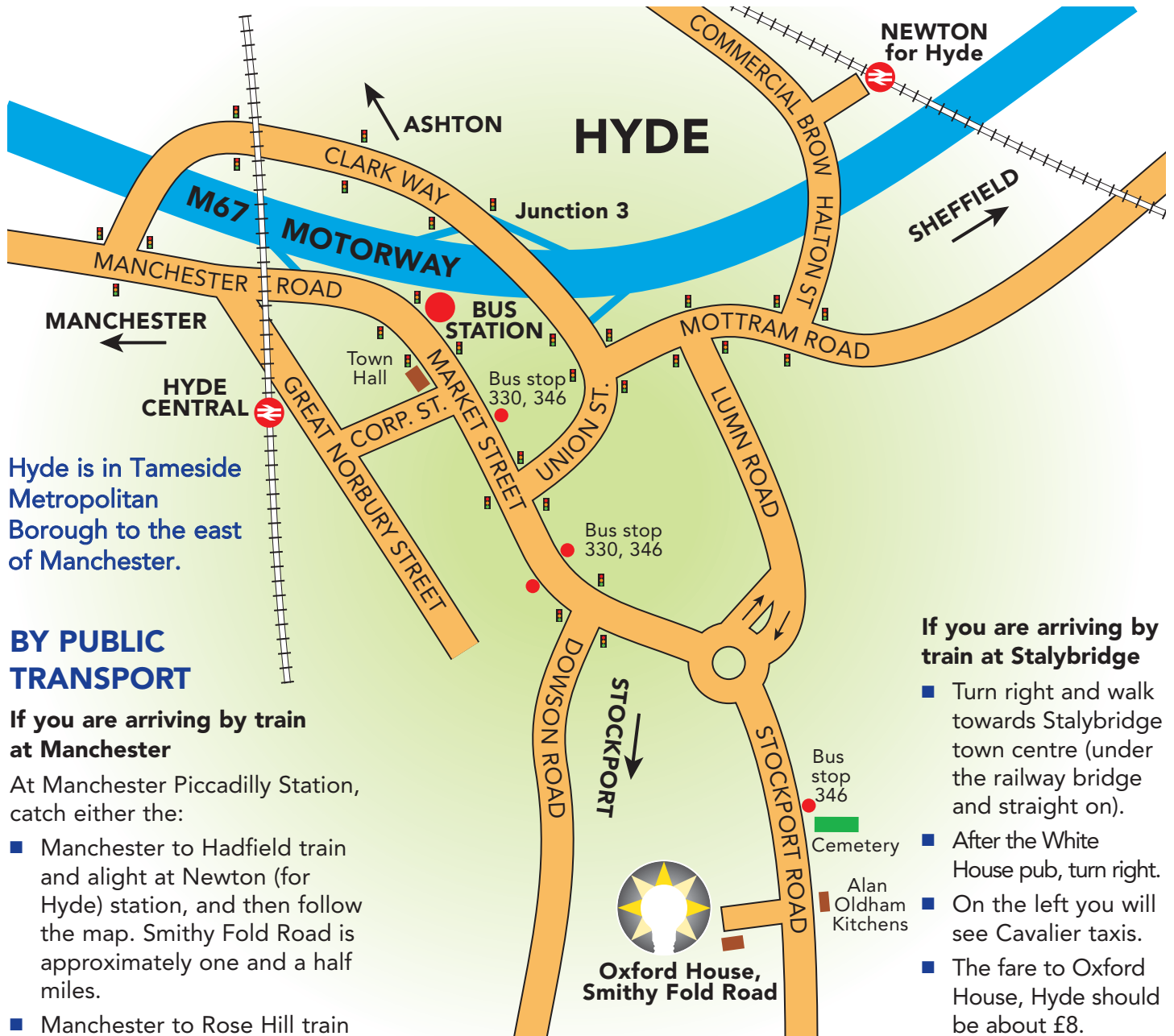


Directions to Richard Armitage Transport Consultancy

Oxford House, Smithy Fold Road, Hyde, Cheshire SK14 5QY



Hyde is in Tameside Metropolitan Borough to the east of Manchester.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

If you are arriving by train at Manchester

At Manchester Piccadilly Station, catch either the:

- Manchester to Hadfield train and alight at Newton (for Hyde) station, and then follow the map. Smithy Fold Road is approximately one and a half miles.
- Manchester to Rose Hill train and alight at Hyde Central station, and then follow the map. Smithy Fold Road is approximately three quarters of a mile.
- A local taxis number is 0161 368 9585.

If you are arriving by train at Stockport. Take Taxi or Bus.

Taxi: There is a rank (immediately outside the station). The fare should be about £9 - £11.

Bus: The bus station is about 5 minutes walk away:

- Walk out of the rail station.
- On left, past a car park entrance, take pedestrian-only route to the bus station.
- Catch the 330 (for Hyde and Ashton-under-Lyne) - runs about every 10 minutes.
- Ask for Hyde, get off at the stop at the top of Market Street, Hyde
- Use the map above to find Smithy Fold Road.

If you are arriving by train at Stalybridge

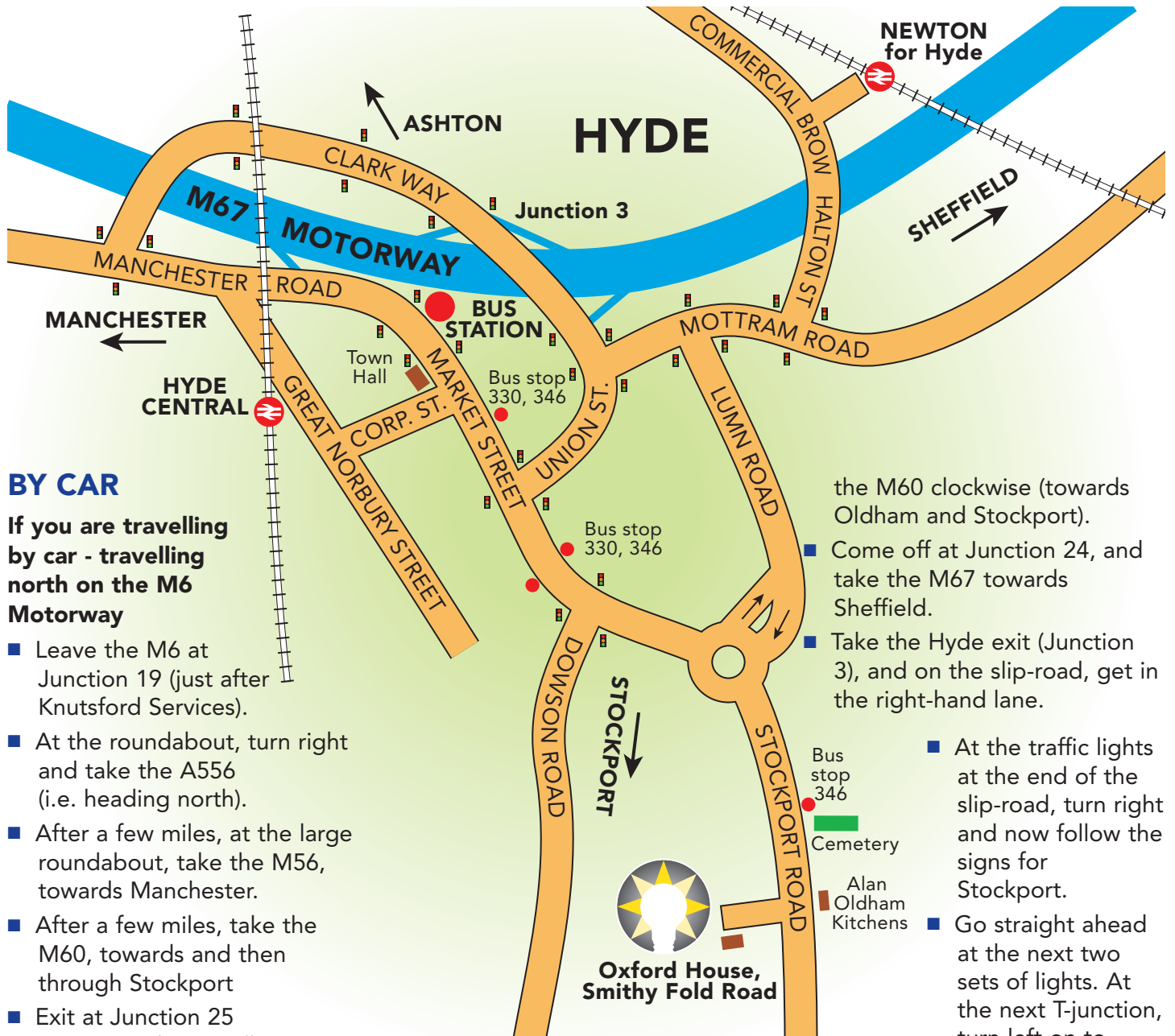
- Turn right and walk towards Stalybridge town centre (under the railway bridge and straight on).
- After the White House pub, turn right.
- On the left you will see Cavalier taxis.
- The fare to Oxford House, Hyde should be about £8.

At Smithy Fold Road

Smithy Fold Road is not paved and is a dead end. It is situated off Stockport Road, directly opposite the shop front of Alan Oldham Kitchens. Oxford House is the only house on the left. On foot, walk up the concrete ramp just before Oxford House, through the gateway arch and turn left for the RATC office. If you arrive by car, please drive past Oxford House and then turn left into the driveway and park there.

BY CAR

If you are travelling by car - travelling north on the M6 Motorway

- Leave the M6 at Junction 19 (just after Knutsford Services).
- At the roundabout, turn right and take the A556 (i.e. heading north).
- After a few miles, at the large roundabout, take the M56, towards Manchester.
- After a few miles, take the M60, towards and then through Stockport
- Exit at Junction 25 (signposted to Bredbury)
- At the first and the second roundabouts, take the second exit each time
- Keep straight ahead until you reach the T junction at the end (Travellers Call pub on your right) – turn left and keep in the lefthand lane.
- Keep straight ahead all the way for a couple of miles. At the Smith Knight Fay VW Audi garage (on your left), turn right (A560 towards Glossop and Sheffield).

- Go up the hill and then through Gee Cross village
- After the Methodist Church (on your left) take the left fork: this is Stockport Road
- Smithy Fold Road is on your left (opposite Alan Oldham Kitchens).

If you are travelling by car on the M60 Motorway

- If you are driving from the west, north or east, you should get on the M62 and then come off at Junction 18 to join

the M60 clockwise (towards Oldham and Stockport).

- Come off at Junction 24, and take the M67 towards Sheffield.
- Take the Hyde exit (Junction 3), and on the slip-road, get in the right-hand lane.
- At the traffic lights at the end of the slip-road, turn right and now follow the signs for Stockport.
- Go straight ahead at the next two sets of lights. At the next T-junction, turn left on to Market Street, going up the hill.
- Keep straight ahead at the next set of traffic lights, then at the Clock Tower roundabout, turn right (i.e. last exit), continuing up the hill.
- After a couple of hundred metres, you will pass the Cemetery on your left. Now look out on your left for the Alan Oldham Kitchens shop front: turn immediately right into Smithy Fold Road.
